



**CURVE LAKE FIRST NATION YOUTH LACROSSE CAMP  
AUGUST 19<sup>TH</sup>, 20<sup>TH</sup>, AND 21<sup>ST</sup>**

**CAMP FORMAT:**

This year's camp will be led by two separate lacrosse based programs: Nationwide Lacrosse and the Iroquois Lacrosse Program.

***Nationwide Lacrosse:*** Co-Founders Brad Self and Shawn Evans are excited to have the opportunity to bring their company - Nationwide Lacrosse to Curve Lake. With their winning backgrounds they are excited to teach the game to the next generation of lacrosse players. Their lacrosse camps will teach the fundamentals of lacrosse. Brad and Shawn believe that having a passion for the game are the two most important qualities that make a great lacrosse player. The camp will include basic fundamental skill development, introduction of the rules of lacrosse, along with fun, competitive games.

***Iroquois Lacrosse Program:*** Kevin Sandy and Cam Bomberry provide a traditional and curriculum based program developed by elite lacrosse players and role models from Six Nations of the Grand River. Curriculum includes: Youth Leadership, Instructional Lacrosse Sessions; and Motivational Speaking. Participants will engage in a number of exercises and discussions about the game of lacrosse and the importance of making healthy and positive choices in life.

There will be absolutely no physical contact permitted. All communication will be positive and reinforcing. The environment to be created and maintained will be safe and healthy for all who participate.

**CAMP SCHEDULE:**

It is anticipated that over 100 CLFN youth will participate in this camp. Therefore, time has been set aside for our youth enrolled at the Day Care and Day Camp to ensure their participation.

- Toddlers (Children 18 months – 3 years) – Morning
- Main Building (Children 3 to 5 years) – Morning
- School Age Program (Children 5 to 12 years) – Afternoon

Note: If your child falls within one of the aforementioned age groups and isn't enrolled at the Day Care please call Jeffrey Jacobs. It is our intent to keep children in the same age group together if and when possible.

**Day 3 – Wednesday August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2013 – Open Session – Youth Ages 18 months – 17 years**

**EQUIPMENT:**

Children are encouraged to bring their own sticks to use. Also, a limited number of sticks will be available to our youth without sticks and who are first time players to keep.

The camp will take place at the main ball diamond and will begin at 9:30 a.m. and end at 3:30 p.m. each day. This is a rain or shine event. There will be no charge for this event. Refreshments will be provided. Lunches or snacks will not. One hour will be allotted for lunch beginning at noon. Participants are on their own for lunch so please make the necessary arrangements for your child(ren).
