Background

Dnaagdawenmag Binnoojiiyag Child & Family Services, is seeking to hire a full time Native Youth & Justice Service Coordinator.

The Native Youth & Justice Service Coordinator will coordinate culturally based supports, advocacy, resource and referral services together with linkages to other mainstream services to assist First Nation/Aboriginal youth between the ages of 12 – 17 at the time of offence, who have been found guilty and are on probation, conditional supervision, community supervision or in custody/detention and preparing for discharge.

Qualifications

- Child & Youth Worker/Social Services Diploma from an accredited University/College with at least two years practical experience and/or four years experience in a related field
- Sound knowledge of First Nation/Aboriginal culture, traditional healing approaches and traditions
- Knowledge and experience of First Nation & urban based programs & services
- Knowledge of adolescent development and specific issues related to First Nation/Aboriginal youth
- Valid Driver's License, reliable vehicle with 2 million liability insurance coverage
- Willingness to travel
- Current CPIC & VPSS
