Learn To Skate Program

This new program is being offered by the Curve Lake Screaming Eagles Tyke Team to ease parents and kids into hockey before the leagues start. Hockey can be stressful for new players and parents and this session is designed to get kids into equipment and onto the ice. It will be a time to play some “hockey” with local friends. For experienced hockey players and parents, this program may not be for you.

There will be 8 on ice lessons, with kids in full hockey equipment, with three experienced, certified instructors from Ennismore Minor Hockey and Canadian Hockey Enterprises. They will teach kids at three basic levels:

- 1st Time Skaters;
- Skaters With No Hockey Equipment Experience;
- Inexperienced Hockey Players (less than two years of organized hockey)

This program is perfect for Curve Lake community members that are 4 (or turn 4) in 2013, 5 year olds and 6 year olds that don't turn seven in 2013. These are the current tyke age limits for the Screaming Eagles Little NHL team.
