# Quinn Meawasige

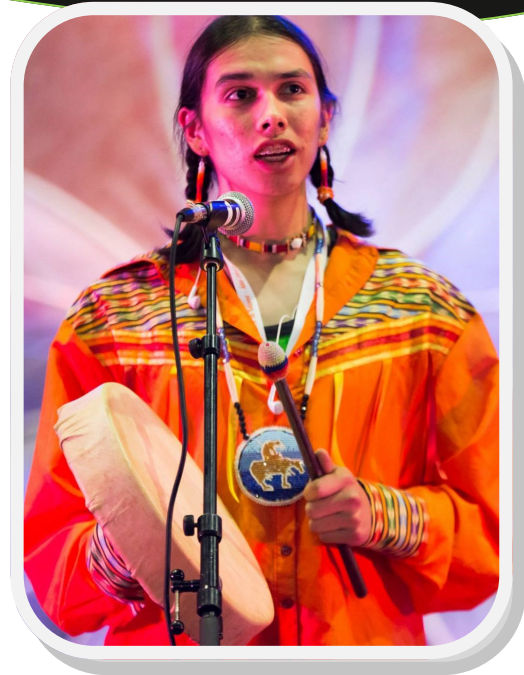
