Sharon Helen Venne (Old woman Bear) is Cree and through marriage, a citizen of the Blood Tribe in Treaty Seven. She has played an active role in the national and international struggles of many Indigenous Peoples, including the Lubicon Cree and Dineh Nation. Sharon has a Masters of Law degree from the University of Alberta, and is presently a doctoral candidate, writing a thesis on the treaty rights of Indigenous peoples and international law. All her work internationally and domestically relates to the promotion of the rights of Indigenous Peoples especially rights related to land, resources and treaties. She has lectured on the rights of Indigenous Peoples in Australia, New Zealand, Norway, Sweden, France, Italy, Hawaii, The United States and Canada
