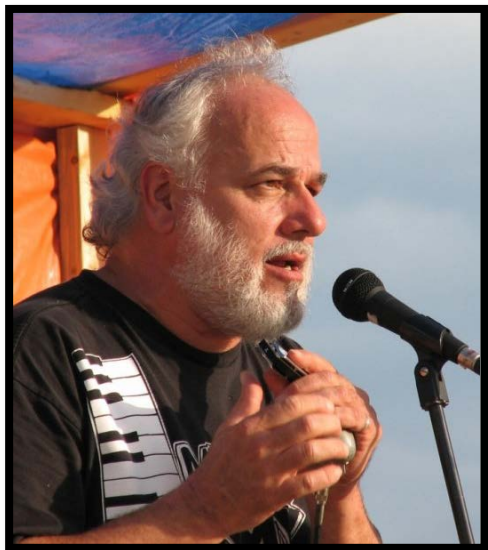


# THE MISSISSAUGA NATION
