AFOA Canada has launched its online National Aboriginal Financial Literacy survey. It is part of a research project on Aboriginal Financial Literacy in Canada. The project objectives are:

(1) To identify the financial literacy needs of Aboriginal peoples in Canada

(2) To develop a national framework that outlines what is needed to build financial literacy wisdom and resiliency in Aboriginal communities.

THE CHALLENGE

In order to gain an understanding of the financial literacy needs of **all** Aboriginal people, responses are needed from all age groups, heritage groups and regions across Canada.
