Water Level Management – Information Session

Council would like to invite the membership of Curve Lake First Nation to this Water Level Management Information Session. This session will provide an overview to the factors that Parks Canada considers when managing the seasonal water levels within the Trent Severn Waterways.

This is an opportunity to ask questions, voice concerns over the impacts of the extreme low and high water levels during seasonal changes and discuss observations we have made from the personal experiences of Curve Lake First Nation members.

Currently, Council is working with Parks Canada to discuss how to incorporate our voice into the management of water levels on the Trent Severn Waterway lakes, including Buckhorn and Chemong Lakes.
